








Year 4 – Project Based Work ‘Habitats’

<p>Design your own habitat and make a model of it. You could use natural and/or man-made resources. Take a photograph of your habitat and email it to school.</p> 	<p>Write a factfile for an imaginary animal that lives in your habitat .</p> <p>Think about :</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> What it eats Predators How it moves Appearance <p>Remember if it eats grass, it should not live in the sea!</p> 	<p>Create some food chains that might exist in your made up habitat or a real one. Remember they all start with a plant, then an animal and then another animal. (The arrows mean -> is eaten by)</p> 
<p>Research how our world is changing environmentally and why.
