

# Years 6 Topic Work Summer Term – The Time For Challenge

 <p><b>Sculpture</b></p> <p>Create a sculpture out of natural resources or resources you have plenty of e.g. stones, twigs, flowers, grass etc. You could use recycling also. Think about: What message does your sculpture give? Why have you designed it in a certain way?</p>	<p><b>Young Enterprise</b></p> <p>In the current climate, there are many people who need our help. Can you come up with a way in which you can support other people through your actions: What you do? What you say? What you write? Promote what you have done through pictures and videos, which can be posted on our school Facebook page, to show what impact your actions have had on others.</p>	<p><b>Physical Challenge</b></p> <p><b>Sally up, Sally Down Challenge.</b></p> <p>Using the song 'Flower' by Moby I would like you to complete a fitness challenge. You could do a squat, lying leg raise, press up (from your knees) etc. Each time you hear 'Sally up' you go up each time you hear 'Sally down', you go down. Can you carry out your chosen exercise for the whole song? Send me a video to post of your amazing feat.</p> 
<p><b>Transition Box</b></p> <p>Create a Transition Box. Put inside the box all the things that make you, you (this could be in the form of pictures), your thoughts about next year, things you are anxious about, things you are excited about, any achievements you think they would want to know about. Hopefully we can then pass these on to your high schools.</p>	<p><b>Poem</b></p> <p>Create a poem about how you have valued the time at home with your family and what you wish for the future. It needs to only have 3 stanzas. They could be based on the themes of:</p> <p><i>What has this time made you realise? What do you no longer take for granted? What do you long for in the future?</i></p> <p>Remember poetry creates an image so use your imagery devices. Oh, and not all poetry rhymes!</p>	<p><b>Create a sequel to a popular children's story.</b></p> <p>Taking one of your favourite children's stories, can you create a sequel? We did this for the Templeton Twins but can you do it for books aimed at Reception children? For example: The Highway Rat – Strikes Again or The Smartest Giant in the Village. Your book needs to include language to engage and create imagery, it might rhyme but it will definitely need illustrations.</p>
<p><b>Audition</b></p> <p>Well, you never know what the future holds, and if we will get to perform a Leavers Assembly (sad music needs to be played hear I think) however can you create a short audition video for me? We will use the Jungle Book as a stimulus. Choose a character, choose a scene and see if you can wow me with your acting skills.</p>	<p><b>Baking – adaptation</b></p> <p>Can you create your own cake, shortbread, biscuit etc? Find a recipe, adapt the recipe, re-write the recipe (think about your English writing skills here) and then make it. Send me the recipe and a picture so we can create a Recipe Book for others in school to try.
