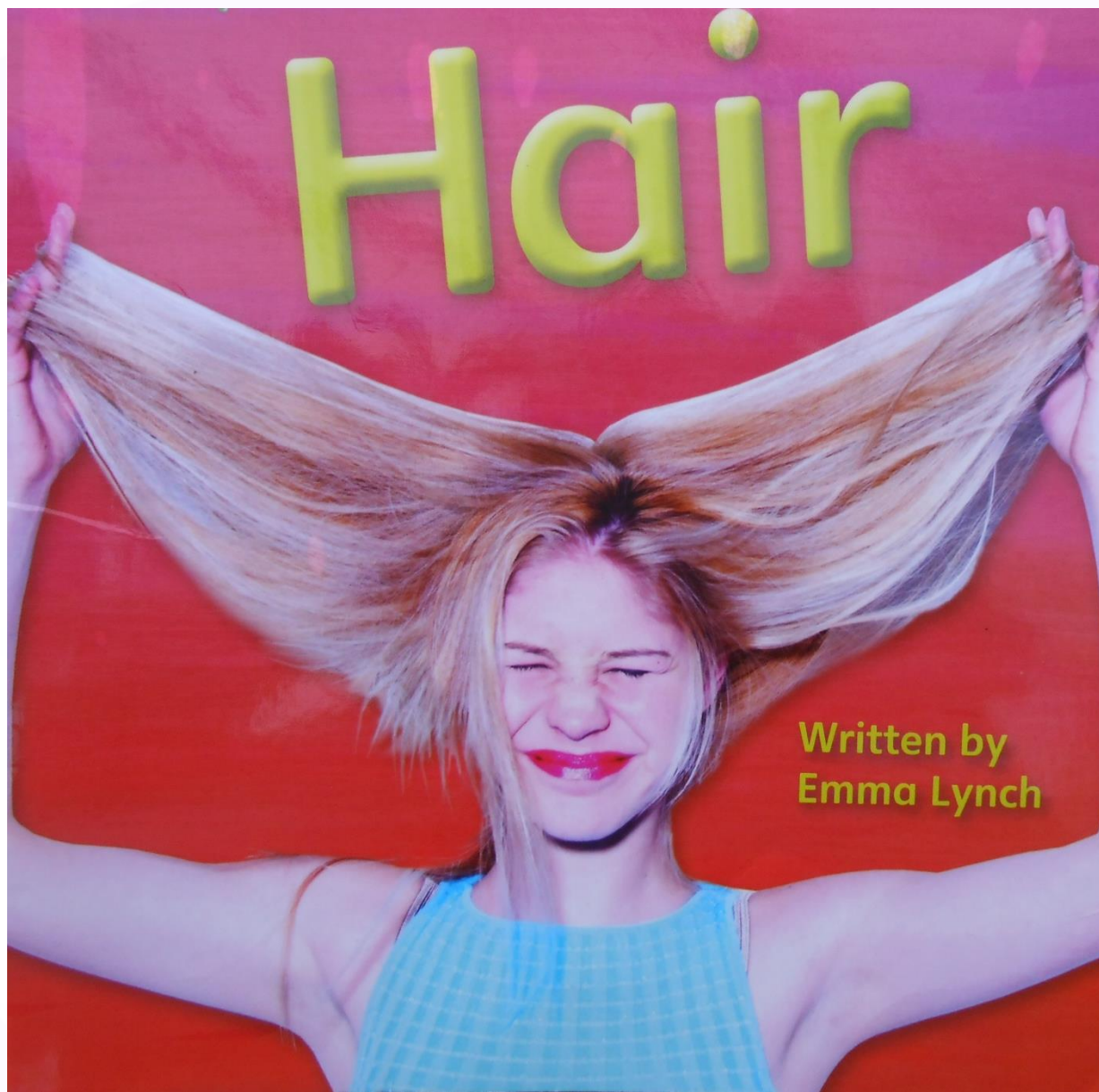

She has got a wig on.**



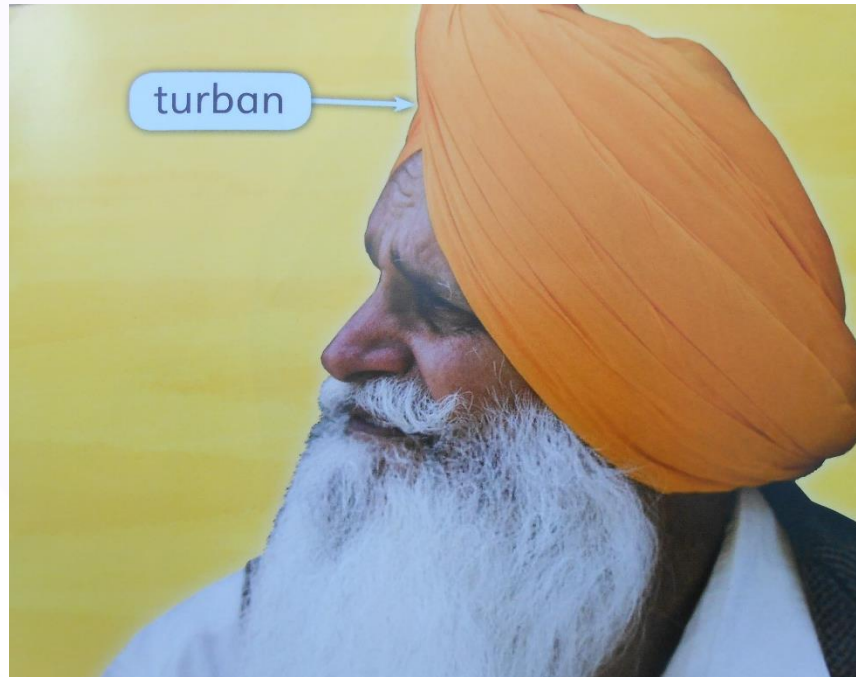
This man has long hair.
