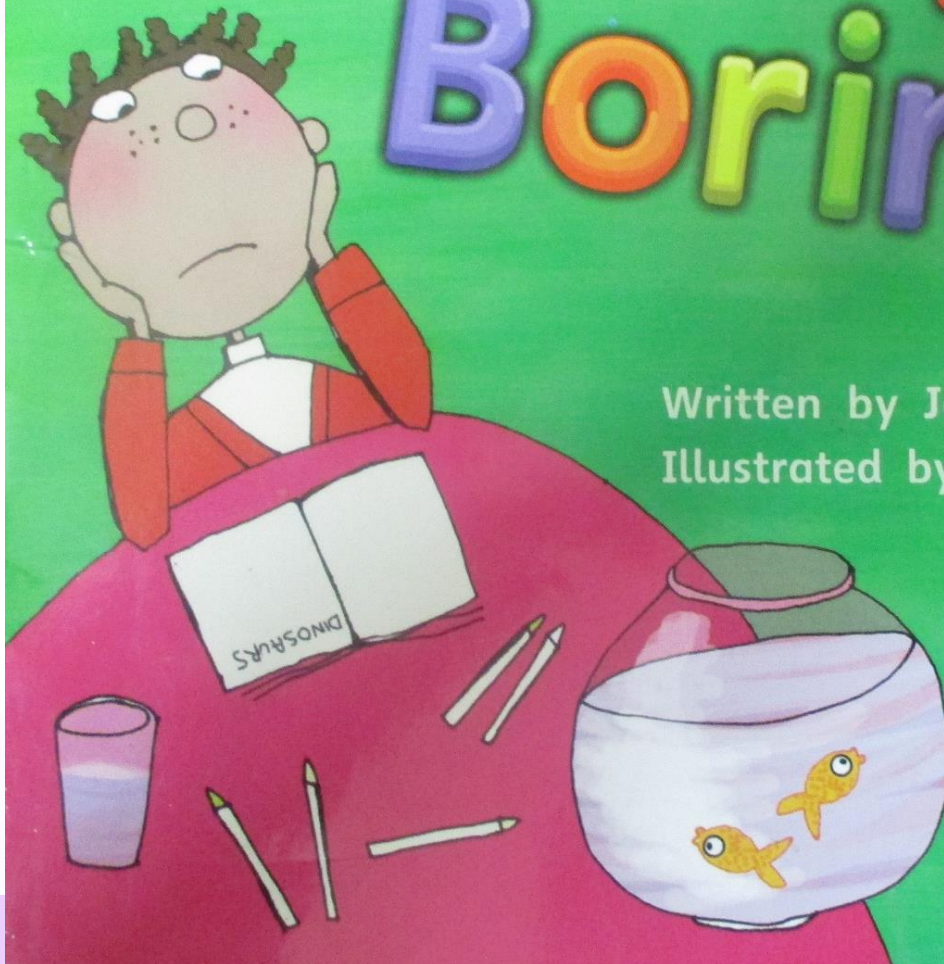

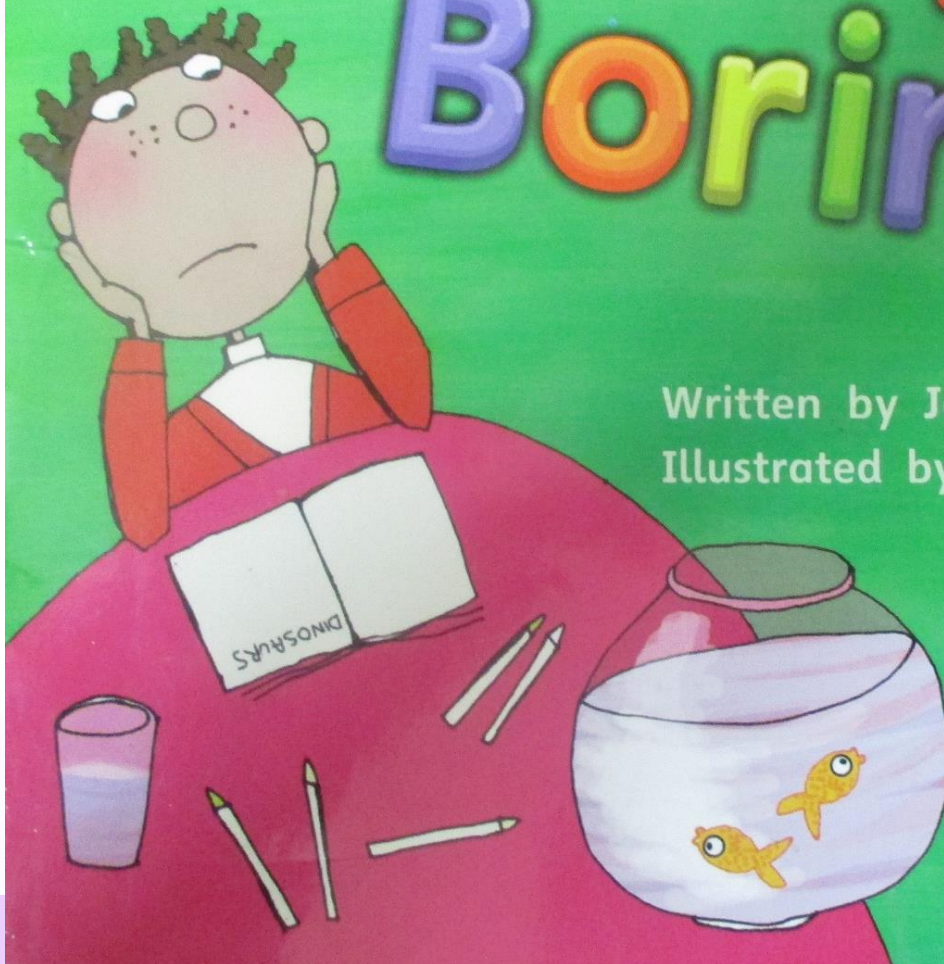

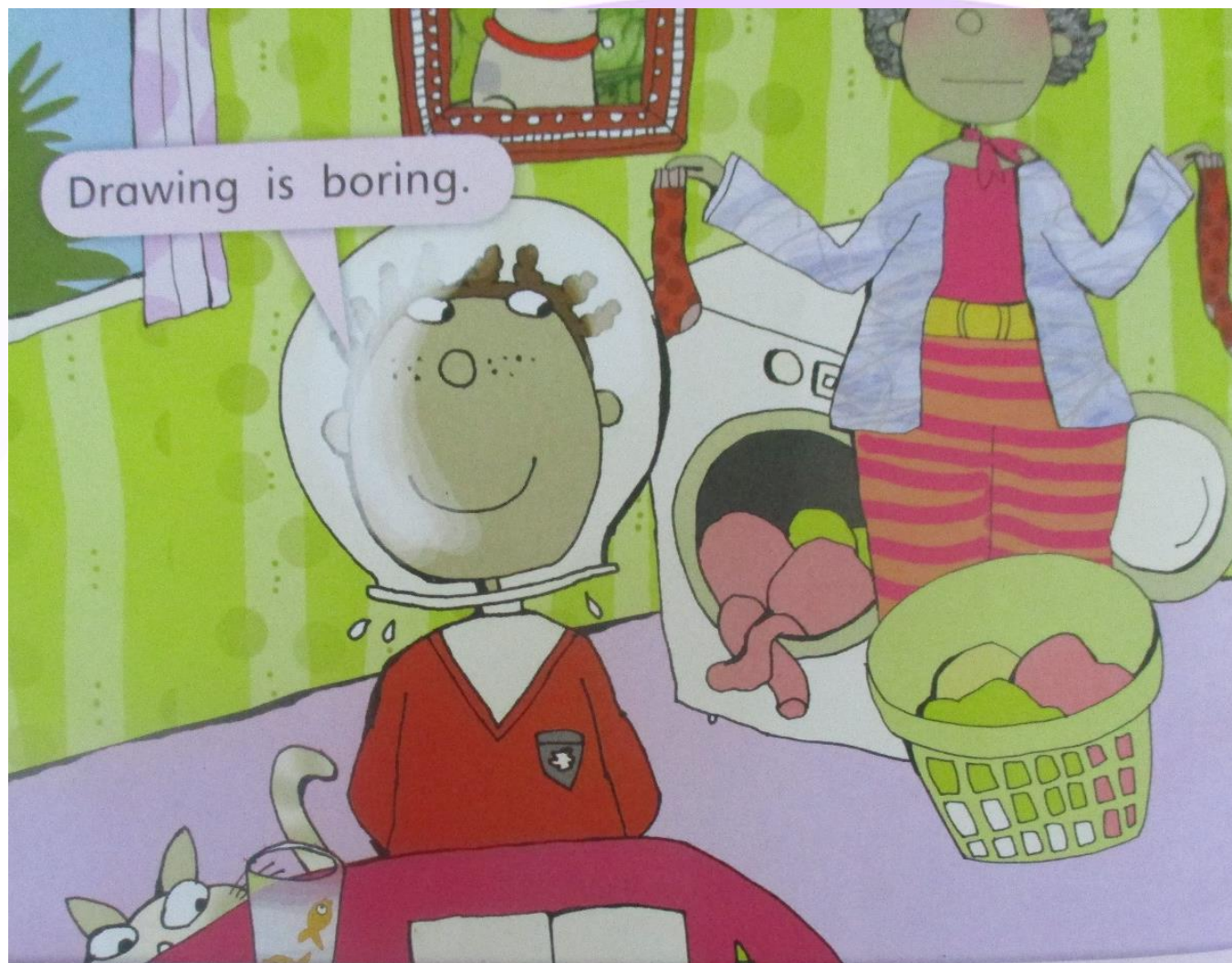


Sid was at Nan's.
