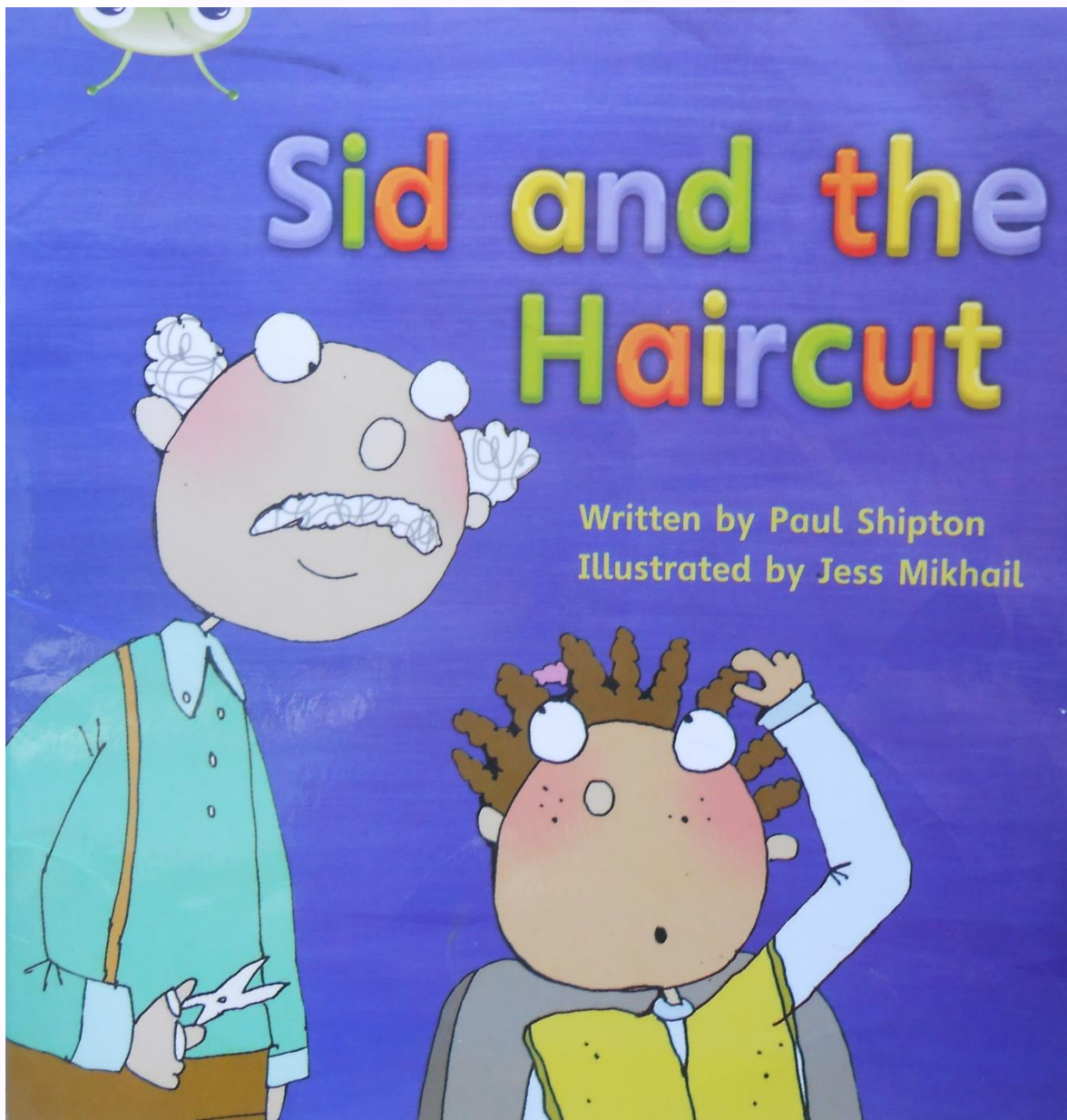

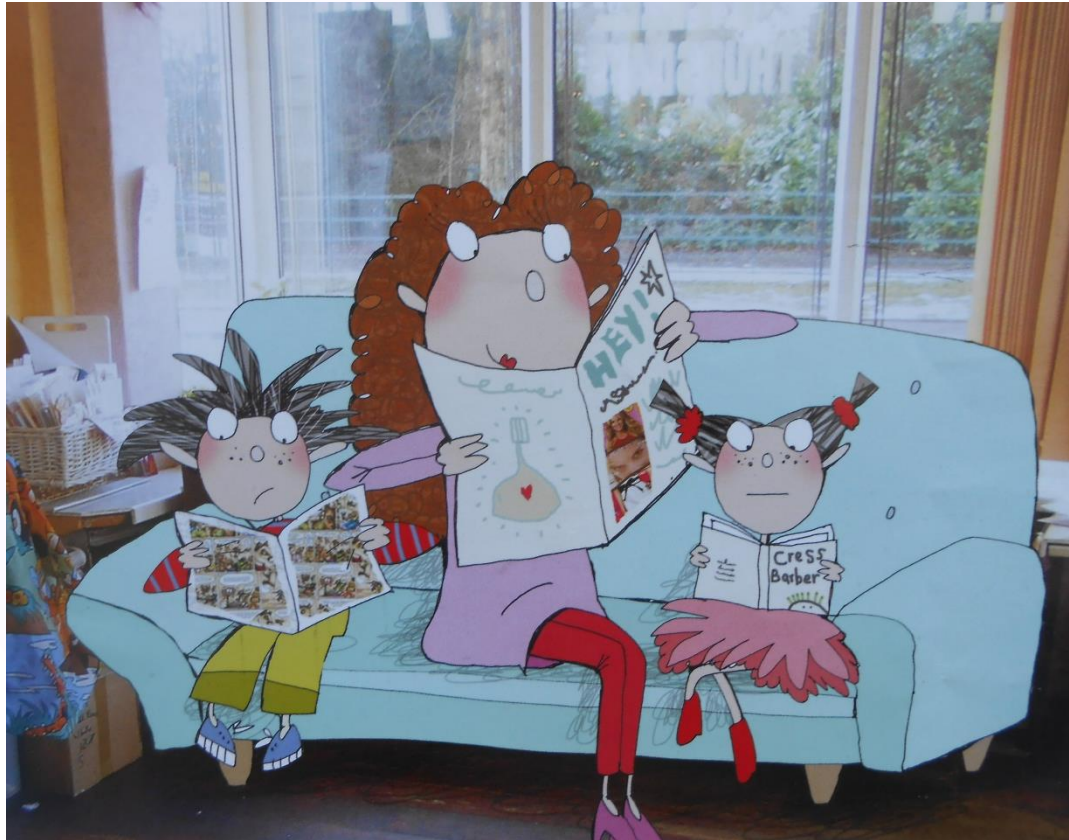
**“You need a haircut,”

**But Robert's mum did not hear. So Sid said, "It's too long!"**

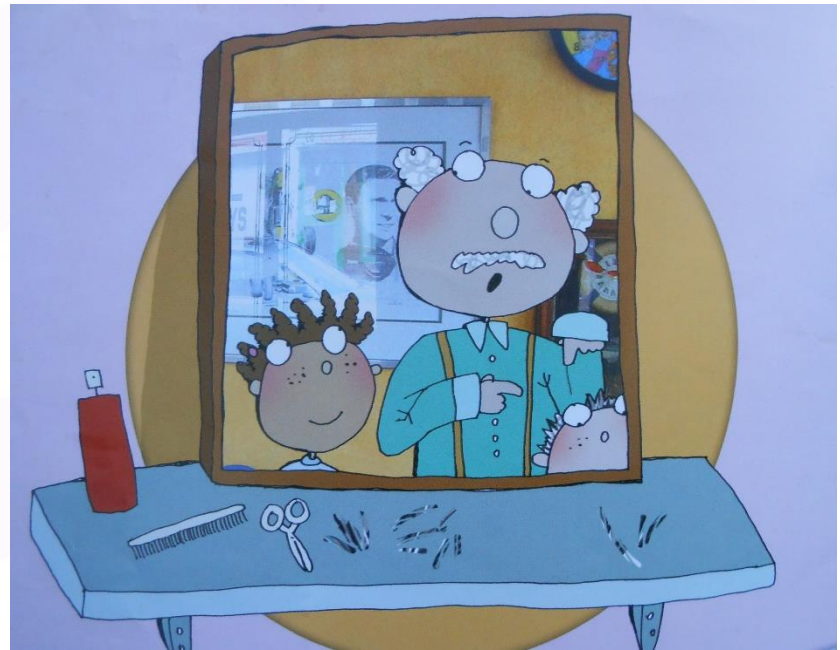


The barber cut and cut.

But Robert's mum did not hear. So Sid said, "It's too long. It must be shorter!"





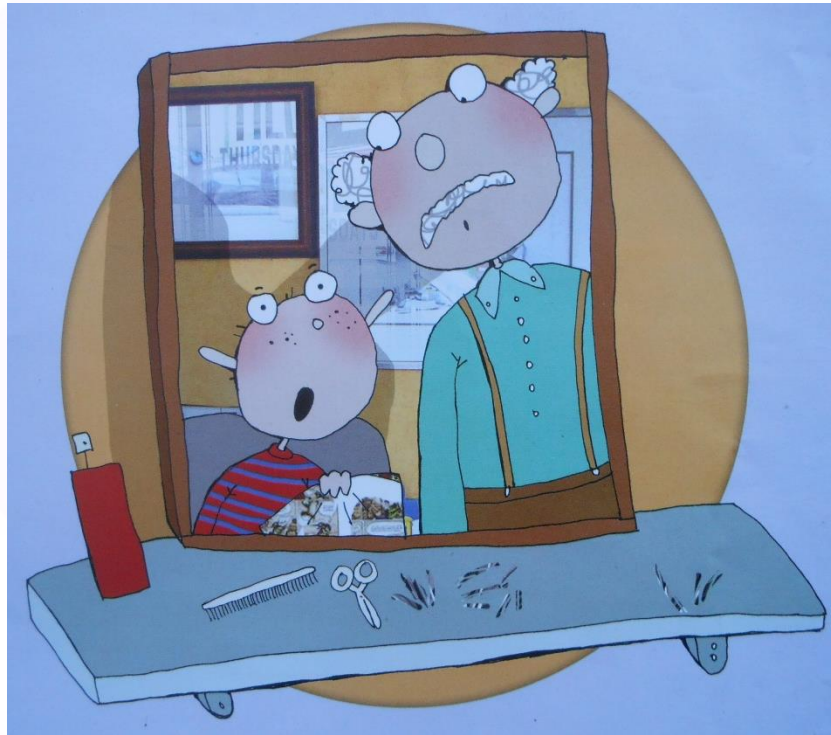
# The barber cut and cut and cut.

I have no hair!”**

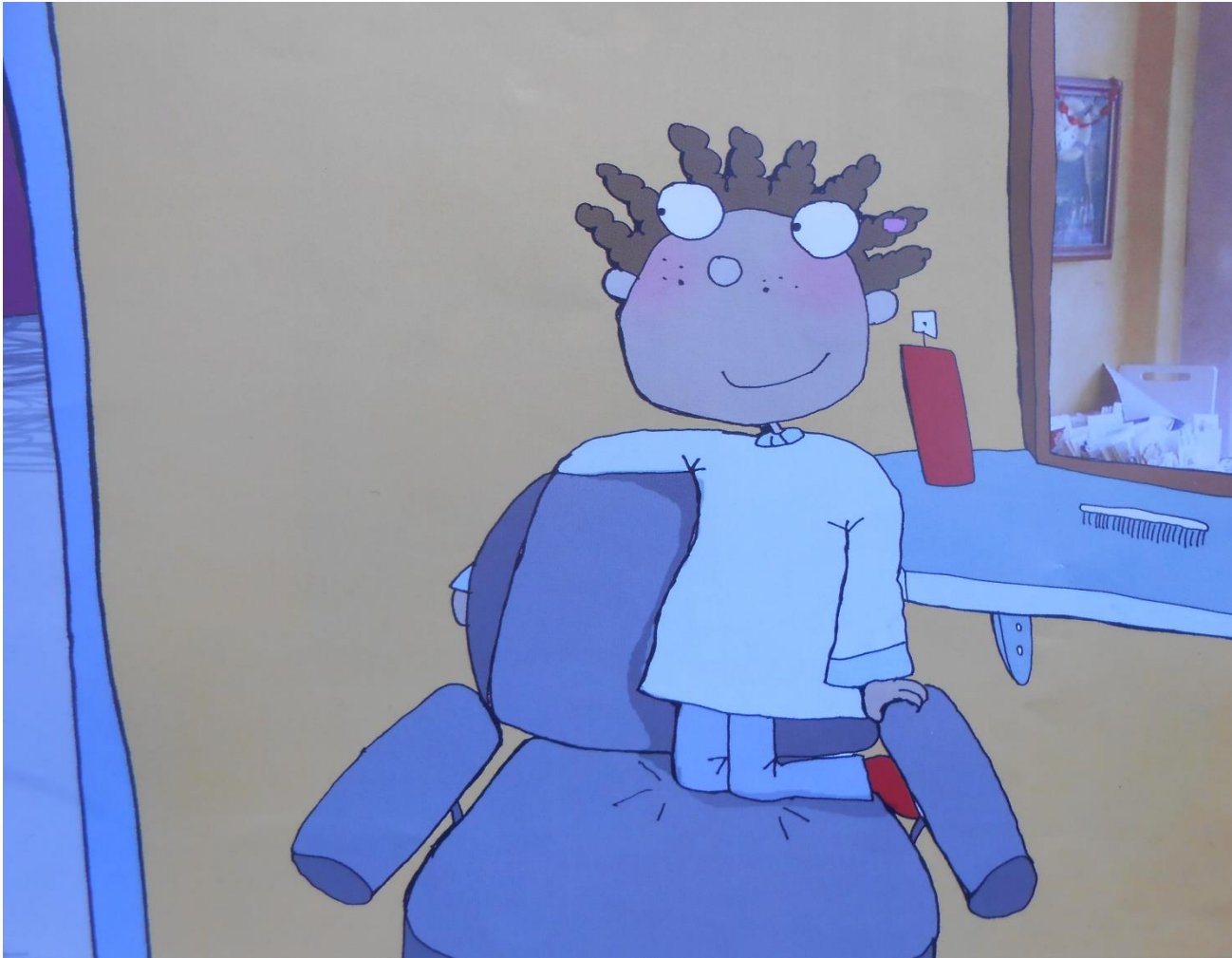




**“Come with me!” said his mum. “We need to get you a hat!”**
