







Ambulance drivers wear bright clothes so we can spot them in a crowd. If they race to help at an accident, we let them through.





Cyclists wear shiny strips on their clothes.

A spaceman wears a helmet and great big gravity boots.







Circus acrobats wear fancy costumes. They look very graceful.




Footballers wear boots with laces at the side. The laces stay out of their way when they kick the ball.




Cricket players protect their legs from the fast pace of the ball.
