PSFA Update

The PSFA will be meeting on Wednesday 8th November in the Cooking Room (room between the gates by the field and the KS2 corridor door), after school. Refreshments will be provided and children can attend.

We will be reviewing the Halloween Discos and finalising plans for Christmas events which include Santa's Grotto, Secret Santa Gift Room, Christmas Bingo and Christmas Chocolate Tombola.

Recently the PSFA have funded the Y6 Leavers' Books, purchased new outdoor play equipment for the Y1 outdoor learning area and end of year book for every child.

Changes to class names and rooms

You will have hopefully noticed that we are increasingly referring to the different classes using their new name rather than Year 1, Year 6 etc. Back in the summer term, the children voted for their favourite trees and we used the results to decide on the new class names which are listed below.

Year 2 – Willow	Year 5 – Beech


Year 6 – Oak Mrs Taylor's Group – Sycamore

We have also changed the way in which we use some rooms in the school to increase the space for meetings and for staff to work with small groups of children.

- The **library** has now moved to the KS2 corridor. (Hopefully you saw this during the parents' evening and Mossgate Portrait Gallery.)
- Mrs Taylor's group (Sycamore class) are now based in what was previously the library.
- The front office has been renamed the **Meeting Room** and will be prioritised for meetings with parents and other agencies.
- Our **Cooking & Community Room** was previously the Breakfast Room and is located between the KS2 corridor door and Y6 classroom with an external door next to the double gate by the field. This room is used by classes when cooking, for PSFA meetings and for small group work.
- My office has moved upstairs and is shared by other senior leaders. My old office, opposite the Quiet Area on the playground, is now known as the PPA Room and used by teachers when they have time out of class to plan their lessons. In the mornings, it is also used by small groups and for 1:1 work.

Earrings Reminder

Please can I remind all parents that small stud earrings are allowed as part of our school uniform - not loops or larger studs. On PE days, children should come to school with earrings removed to minimise the risk of injury from increased physical activity during PE lessons.





Parking Safety

Following a number of parking complaints recently from residents and parents, Lancashire Constabulary are increasing their patrols before and after school at Mossgate. Please can I remind parents to:

- Not park on the zig-zags or coned areas outside of school
- Not to park at junctions
- Not to double park
- Not to park close to private driveways so residents can use

Please be respectful and courteous to other drivers, residents and families by parking slightly away from school to keep the local area as safe as possible for our children.
